There has been postings in other school boards for people that are interested that will take the placement. They were able to cover a few positions, but not all.
- We need someone here to fix the problems within the school.
- There should be someone appointed to the school from spring, but will not start until the new year. We need someone that is seasoned, strong, experienced, and willing to come here.
- To have someone start between now and June would be hard.
- Associate Director were talking about the issues

- For our June 1&12 events they are trying to be there and Brian will be here and help if we don't have an acting Principal and he will help to support the event
- (Parent)- Parents that aren't part of council are not aware of what is happening within the school, and asking the trustee to make a letter that goes out to the school.
- (Parent) Effective communication with the parents minutes need to be out sooner because by the time they are it is outdated.
- (Parent) The kids need stability- the kids are running the school, and they need a principal to show this stability and being on the 4th principal doesn't show that. There has been a change in the school. The kids have already gone through enough with covid, and behaviour issues are off the hook. They don't respect the teachers, and principals. It is a changed community with not having the proper support.
- Trust that he will get a principal for the schoool and he will try his best.
